- American Red Cross or equivalent certification in First Aid
- American Red Cross or equivalent certification in CPR
- 8 hours of provider training

 - MUI
 - Universal Precautions for infection control, including hand washing and the disposal of bodily waste.

Agency Provider Requirements

- Verification of age
- High School Diploma/GED

- Current report from the Bureau of Criminal Identification and Investigation (BCII)
- Certification from the Secretary of State for business identification
- Letter from the IRS verifying your Tax Identification Number
- Bachelor's Degree from an accredited university/college or 4 years' experience
- Proof of experience documenting and evidencing one year of paid, full-time work experience in the provision of services to individuals with developmental disabilities in the areas of supervision of staff; personnel matters; financial management; and supervision of services.
